Itinerary of the 8 Day Norfolk Island Tour.

DAY 1 WEDNESDAY NORFOLK ISLAND/ COMMANDANT DINNER

Leave from Sydney International Airport at 9.45am for our direct flight to Norfolk Island. Lunch will be provided on our flight. DAY 6 MONDAY CYCLORAMA / ISLAND FISH FRY

This afternoon we are off to the Norfolk Island Cyclorama, a purpose built circular building with an internal mural depicting the story of the Bounty Mutineers from their departure in Portsmouth to their final resting place on Norfolk Island. The mural took almost two years to complete and is a must see for every visitor to Norfolk Island. We are picked up around 4.30pm for our transfer to a location for our Island Fish Fry Dinner. This event has been running for over 40 years and promises great food, entertainment, and beautiful sunset views. Watch the sound and light show while tucking into local specialties like sweet potato mash, savory banana slice, coconut pie, and of course fresh ocean fish.

DAY 7 TUESDAY TRIAL OF 15 SHOW

Breakfast at leisure. Lunch will be at the Resort.
