Day 1 Sydney - Darwin

Depart from Sydney Airport with our direct flight approx 8.20am to Darwin arriving around 12.20pm. Our coach will meet us and escort us to our overnight accommodation via a tour of the city. There is free time this afternoon to explore Darwin.

Dinner is in the Resort restaurant.

Accommodation: Travelodge Resort, Darwin

Day 2 Darwin - Kununurra

Breakfast at 7.30am this morning before leaving 8.30am for the airport for our morning flight to Kununurra. We will arrive in Kununurra mid morning to meet our coach. We will have a tour of Kununurra including the Ord River Irrigation Valley, the Diversion Dam, Ivanhoe Crossing followed by a BBQ Lunch with refreshments at Pandanus Beach near the Diversion Dam.

After lunch we will visit Kelly's Knob Lookout with views over the Irrigation Valley & the township & then some free time in town. We will check in to our accommodation for the next 3 nights around 3.00pm. Afternoon free to relax & have perhaps a swim in the resort's pool.

All our meals will be served in the restaurant.

Early Breakfast at 7.00am as we leave for Lake Argyle 8.00am (don't forget your swimmers & towel). On arrival at Lake Argyle we have a 9.00am tour through Argyle Homestead, once the home



to Patsy Durack. Followed by our 2 hour luncheon cruise on Lake Argyle, Australia's largest man-made lake with a capacity nine times that of Sydney Harbour. It's here over lunch there is a chance to swim in the lake. After this, an experience never to be forgotten as we board our vessel at 1.50pm near the Lake Argyle Dam Wall as we cruise 55 km of the majestic Ord River back to Kununurra.

The cruise of the East Kimberley showcases the scenery of Carlton Gorge & its magnificent nature, flora, wildlife, gorges and prolific birdlife. We arrive in Kununurra at sunset approx 5.30pm. where our coach meets us to take us back to our accommodation. Dinner in the resort's restaurant.

Day 4

BUNGLE BUNGLE FLIGHT - WYNDHAM - DURACK RANGES

An early start as we have arranged a *2 hour Bungle Bungle Scenic flight*. The magnificent orange and black strip domes that resemble a beehive, are best seen in the early morning sun. We also fly over Lake Argyle, The Argyle Diamond Mine, Carr Boyd Ranges, Osmand Ranges, The Ord & Bow Rivers. Our pilot delivers a well informed commentary via the provided headphones.

Upon return, after breakfast, we travel north to Wyndham, situated on the Cambridge Gulf, capturing the waters of the Ord, Pentecost, Durack, King & Forrest Waters. From West Bastion Hill (5 Rivers Lookout) overlooking the old wharf,



meatworks site and the vast tidal dunes. After lunch we stop for a photo of the large crocodile statue in the park. We then tour the Ord River Hoochery Distillery and learn about the Ord Rum and other liqueurs. Our farewell Dinner is in the resort's restaurant.

Day 5

KING LEOPOLD RANGES - HALLS CREEK



Breakfast at leisure as we farewell our hosts for any last minute shopping and then leave Kununurra for the Great Northern Highway, as we travel south following the King Leopold Rangers arriving at our lunch stop at Warmun (Turkey Creek) Roadhouse.

We leave here at 2.00pm passing the Bungle Bungle Range (Purnululu National Park) turnoff and call into the Halls Creek Information Centre, before checking into our overnight accommodation.

Dinner is in the Hotel's restaurant.

Accommodation: Comfort Inn Kimberley Hotel, Halls Creek.

Day 6

Halls Creek - Derry

After breakfast we follow the Great Northern Highway with the Mueller Ranges alongside us stopping at Mary Pool Campground 10.15am / 11.00am near Berrangi Bridge for morning tea. We then reach Fitzroy River Lodge for an early lunch stop.

It's on to Derby, the first town settled in the Kimberley, founded on the vast pioneering pastoral industry & stopping at the Boab Prison Tree & the great long cattle trough. The cattle trough is 140 ft long and was originally built to help with the transporting of cattle to the wharfs in Derby. Farmers could stop here overnight and let their cattle have water before the last run into Derby. The trough can feed 500 bullocks at one time. The trough



used to be filled by natural bore water under its own pressure, but now the water is fed by a windmill pump. We leave here for our overnight accommodation in Derby. Our dinner will be in the Hotel Restaurant

Accommodation: Spinifex Hotel, Derby.

After an early breakfast, we leave for Derby Airport to connect for our half day experience, that includes a spectacular scenic flight over the Buccaneer Archipelago with a seaplane landing onto the calm waters of Talbot Bay followed by a powered boat experience over the Horizontal Falls. Experience firsthand the incredible tidal power of this natural phenomenon as you are taken over the moving water with the highly experienced skippers.

It's here, where the 2nd largest tides in the world move through two coastal gorges and create a 'horizontal waterfall' effect. Relax as you cruise the surrounding bays and creeks of this pristine wilderness area.

Afterwards, we will enjoy a cooked BBQ Barramundi lunch on the floating pontoon. It's here. you can have an opportunity to meet face to face resident sharks as you take a refreshing swim in one of the huge protected shark cages. This is a truly memorable experience and a highlight of the tour.



We arrive back in Derby at 2.15pm to meet our coach as we travel to Broome with a rest stop at the Roebuck Plains Roadhouse before arriving in Broome around 5.30pm for our accommodation for the next 3 nights.

Dinner 7.00pm in the Resort's Restaurant.

Accommodation: Cable Beach Oaks Sanctuary Resort.

Day 8 Broome Sightseeing



After breakfast we leave for a town tour including a visit to Gantheaume Point, where at low tide dinosaur footprints can be seen as well as Anastasia's Pool.

We then visit the Japanese and Chinese cemetery which bears stark witness to the perils faced by the early pearl divers.

A BBQ lunch will be enjoyed at Town Beach, Roebuck Bay. Free time in town is available for some retail therapy shopping.

We then head back to our resort with the rest of the afternoon free.

Early this evening we will venture to Cable Beach for sunset drinks & nibbles to watch the sunset over the Indian Ocean followed by Dinner right next door at Zanders Restaurant on Cable Beach.

Day 9 Willie Creek Pearl Farm

After breakfast we leave for Willie Creek Pearl Farm to meet our guides & firstly learn about the



modern pearling techniques & how Broome produces some of the finest pearls in the world.

We will then have morning tea with some home cake overlooking the waterway. Following this you will enjoy the cruise on the magnificent turquoise waters of Willie Creek & more about the cultivation of the pearls. You may even sight a SaltWater Crocodile sunbaking on the sandbanks.

Some time in the sales shop followed by a delicious "surf & turf" lunch

that will finish up our day at Willie Creek, before returning back to our motel for some free time.


Our farewell tour Dinner will be at 6.30pm in the Resort's Restaurant.
