Itinerary of the 7 day Kangaroo Island & Adelaide Tour

DAY 1

ADELAIDE

We leave Sydney on our late morning flight & arrive in Adelaide around lunch time.

On arrival our coach meets us for a tour of Port Adelaide & the City..

We'll then visit Montefiore Hill which overlooks the City & Adelaide Oval for a photo shoot. The Art Gallery of South Australia, lies within close proximity of Adelaide's CBD, where you'll have a chance to stretch your legs, with some time for some window shopping as well.

We are then transferred to our Motel in the seaside suburb of Glenelg to settle into our overnight accommodation before dinner.

DAY 2

ADELAIDE

After breakfast we travel south to **Victor Harbour** to get a "behind the scenes" experience of the **Clydesdale Horses** that still to this day, pull the trams over the Causeway to Granite Island. You'll enjoy a generous Devonshire Morning tea, whilst learning about the rich history of this "mode" of transport.

We also get to see first hand how these magnificent horses are cared for and prepared before they are put to work on the tramway. This is an experience to remember, as the very caring staff guide us through the horse's journey.



It's then off to Victor Harbour to enjoy a ride on the tram to **Granite Island** followed by some free time for lunch of your choosing at your expense thereafter, in the seaside village.

Upon return to our accommodation we will stop in the **McLaren Vale** winery region and visit the **Fleurieu Art House** situated in the historic and well cared for grounds of Hardy's Tintara Winery. There will be time to enjoy the vast variety of exhibits of Art and Craft, as well as talk to the artists in the workshop thereafter.

It's then back to Glenelg for a well earned rest ahead of dinner at a local restaurant tonight.



After breakfast we'll head east to the stunning Adelaide Hills district. First stop will be morning tea at the unique and historic **Standgate House and Garden**, at Aldgate.

These grounds are owned by the National Trust of South Australia.

The architect behind this landscape is the renowned garden designer, Elsie Cornish who is well known for her colour and arrangements.



It's then off to the old historic German village of **Hahndorf**, the oldest surviving German settlement in Australia.

You'll have some free time to wander the shops and choose a lunch location at your own expense, from a myriad of eateries.

The colours of the Autumn Blaze Maple and Chinese Pistache trees that line the main street of Hahndorf, are simply brilliant this time of the year.

Mid afternoon we will head back to our accommodation at Glenelg, allowing free time to explore our seaside location before dinner at a nearby restaurant, that night.

DAY 4

KANGAROO ISLAND

After breakfast, it's time to say farewell to Glenelg as we make our way to Cape Jarvis, to catch our 45 min Sealink Ferry ride to Penneshaw Port, **Kangaroo Island**, the third largest island off the coast of Australia. This largely unspoiled wilderness with its abundance of flora and fauna, spectacular rock formations, beautiful beaches and peaceful lagoons make it a photographer's dream.



We connect with a local coach and head straight for a hearty lunch at the Penneshaw Hotel. After lunch it's off to **Dave and Jenny Clifford's Honey Farm**.

Dave has over 50 years of beekeeping experience and you'll enjoy an informative talk about the industry as well as a variety of honey tastings. Jenny's honey ice cream is famous too.



After a short drive, we will arrive around 4pm to our accommodation, **The Seaside Inn at Kingscote, Kangaroo Island** for the next 3 nights.

After checking in you will have time to explore Kingscote, the main town on Kangaroo Island before dinner in the hotel's restaurant.

Breakfast and Dinners will be in the hotel's restaurant.

DAY 5

KANGAROO ISLAND

We depart after breakfast for a full day of touring. We leave here for **Seal Bay** for a guided walk along the beach to see the rare Australian Sea Lions at rest and play.

You'll be taken to the heart of an uncaged colony and given an insight into how they fish, surf and interact with their pups.

It's then off to the amazing **Birds of Prey show**, where you'll see a variety of Kestrels, Owls, Kookaburras and Wedge Tail Eagles on display with their keepers.



Lunch will be enjoyed at the **Emu Ridge Eucalyptus Distillery**, where a tour and story of how the oil is extracted follows thereafter. This oil is produced from the KI Narrow-Leaf Mallee.

The afternoon is capped off with a visit to the **Bay of Shoals Winery** for a tasting and chat about the industry on the Island.

It's then home for a rest ahead of dinner at the hotel that night.

DAY 6

KANGAROO ISLAND

A hearty breakfast before we leave with our first stop at the **Flinders Chase National Park**, a natural wonderland and sanctuary for native wildlife. The chase also reveals the aptly named **Remarkable Rocks & Admirals Arch**, huge granite boulders balancing on the cliff's edge.



Upon return, we will visit Point Ellen then enjoy a delicious 2 course lunch at **Vivonne Bay Bistro**, the only building in the area to survive the treacherous fires from the summer 2019 / 2020.

Afterwards, there will be free time to stretch the legs and further explore Kingscote and its shops, ahead of our last night and dinner on the Island.

DAY 7

HOMEWARD BOUND

After an early breakfast we are transferred back to the ferry port of Penneshaw for our ferry back to Jervis Bay and coach transfer to Adelaide airport thereafter.

Our early afternoon flight arrives back to Sydney at approximately 4.30pm that day.
